## Called to Humility

In culture today much time is spent on proving our point or proving someone else is wrong. We want to justify our position at the expense of others. Is this how believers are called to live?

Yesterday we kicked off a series in 1 Thessalonians and the call to the believer was to walk in such a way that "God would consider worthy." We find this same theme in the letter to the church at Ephesus.

Paul writes in Ephesians 4:1-2 "Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God. Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love."

Paul connects a worthy walk with being humble, gentle, and loving. What if these 3 things were our first goal rather than trying to be right or proving someone else wrong? When we lead with these 3 things it changes how we approach others and our positions. May humility, gentleness, and love be what defines your interactions with others this week.




